VOTING IN NEW CANAAN

REGISTERING TO VOTE:

Who: You must be a U.S. citizen, town resident, and at least 17 years old (voters must be 18 by the date of the General Election).

Where: Register to vote online at <https://voterregistration.ct.gov> using your DMV-issued ID, at the DMV, in person at the Town Registrars or Town Clerk (8:00 am to 4:30 pm), or by mail. Get mail-in forms from Town Clerk, Registrars, or the library.

When: Register at least 7 days prior to an election. Any person who attains 18, moves within the town, or becomes a U.S. citizen within 7 days of an election may apply in person at the Registrar’s office. You may both register and vote at the Town Clerk at Town Hall on Election Day.

ENROLLMENT IN A POLITICAL PARTY AND PRIMARY VOTING:

****CT primaries currently scheduled for August 9, 2022****

There are two Major Parties in CT, Democratic and Republican; and several Minor Parties, including Green, Independent, Libertarian, and Working Families. If you do not enroll in a political party, you are considered to be "unaffiliated." You may only participate in a party’s primary election or caucus if you are enrolled in that party. You can affiliate with a political party when you register to vote or you can choose a political party at a later date, by mail the Thursday before, or in person by noon the day before a primary.

If you want to change your party affiliation, complete another voter registration application and check the box "Party Enrollment Change". You can do this online with your DMV-issued ID. You must change your party affiliation 3 months prior to a caucus or primary to have voting privileges.

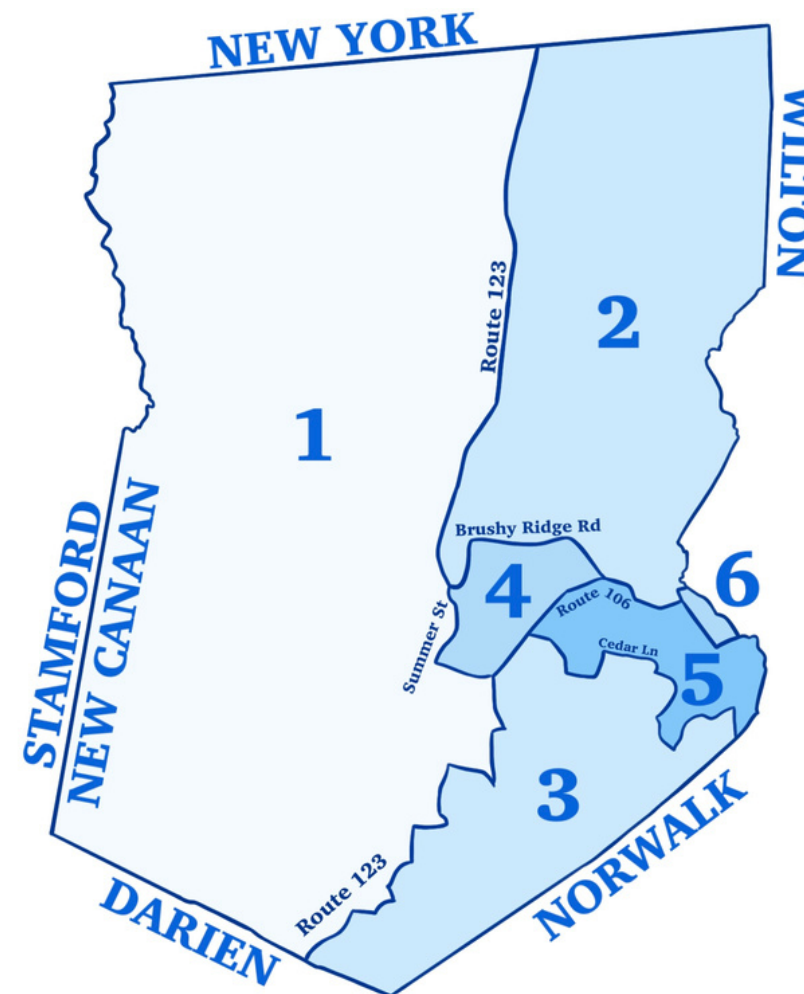

VOTING IN GENERAL ELECTIONS:

At the polls on Election Day: See map description for polling locations. Polls are open 6:00 am to 8:00 pm. Same day registration and voting at Town Clerk's Office

By absentee ballot: You may only vote by absentee ballot if you cannot vote in person on Election Day. In CT this includes any person who will be out of town during all voting hours of Election Day, active members of the armed forces, persons with illness, physical disability or religious beliefs that prevent them from voting in person on Election Day, and election officials who are performing duties at a polling place other than their own during all election hours. You can pick up absentee ballot applications from Town Clerk starting 21 days before a primary or 30 days before a regular election. Without registering as an application distributor, you may pick up applications for family members plus up to 4 additional applications for non-family members. You may also download and print (on legal-sized paper only) an absentee ballot application at portal.ct.gov/SOTS and select "Elections and Voting" in left side menu. Send applications to Town Clerk to receive ballot. Return your completed ballot according to the instructions given to you to the Town Clerk, in person or mail, by 8:00 p.m. on Election Day. No absentee ballot can be presented in person at the polls.
