

## VOTE BY ABSENTEE BALLOT (MAIL)

Fast Facts



Applications automatically mailed out mid-September to all voters registered as of August 26th. Use this application if possible as bar coding will expedite processing. The return envelope is postage-paid, so you don't need a stamp.

- OR -

If you applied for an AB, it will be mailed to you October 2-9. If you don't receive it by October 19th, call the Town Clerk at New Canaan Town Hall to ask for one.

COVID-19 is a valid excuse for voting AB. You MUST check a box stating your reason.

You MUST sign and date your own AB

application. Parents can't sign for kids,

nor spouses for each other.

Mark your ballot carefully! Unlike in-person voting, you can't get another ballot if you make a mistake.

Insert completed ballot into inner

envelope, seal it, sign your name at

"X" on outside of envelope.

IMPORTANT: If the inner envelope isn't

sealed and signed, the ballot won't

count!

AB applications and completed ballots should be placed in Official Ballot Drop Box outside the back of Town Hall (by the parking lot). No other forms should be placed there.







Other than an immediate family member OR designee (if voter is sick or has a disability), no one can take a voter's AB from their home to the mailbox or Official Ballot Drop Box.







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## VOTING TIMELINE



AB applications mailed by CT Secretary of State to all eligible voters. It arrives coded to your name, so it saves our town's election officials time if you use this one to apply. It also contains a self-addressed stamped return envelope. Complete and return the AB application as soon as possible, either by U.S. Mail or, more preferably, the Town Hall Official Ballot Drop Box behind Town Hall.



If you have NOT received your AB application in the mail, go to myvote.ct.gov to print, fill out, and place your application in a sealed envelope. To return it, we encourage you to drop it in the Town Hall Official Ballot Drop Box behind Town Hall. If you send it by U.S. Mail, remember to use a postage stamp!



AB ballots will be mailed by New Canaan Town Clerk to all who requested them. A self-addressed stamped return envelope will be included. Carefully complete your ballot and get it back right away, either by U.S. Mail or, more preferably, the Town Hall Official Ballot Drop Box behind Town Hall.

If you filled out and returned an AB, you can check whether it was received at myvote.ct.gov. If your ballot was NOT yet received, you may still go to the polls to vote in person.

If you did NOT fill out and return an AB, you may vote in person at your regular polling place between 6:00am - 8:00pm.
