Voting in New Canaan

To register to vote in NC you must be a U.S. citizen, town resident, and at least 17 years old. To vote in a general election you must be 18 by that day, but may also vote in the primary for that election if then 17. Register at least 7 days before an election online at www.ct.gov, at the DMV, or in person with Registrars or Town Clerk, 8:30 am to 4:30 pm, or by mail. Get mail-in forms from Town Clerk, Registrars, or the library. Any person who attains 18, moves within the town, or becomes a U.S. citizen within 7 days of an election may apply in-person at the Registrar's office. CT allows election-day registration for the general election. Check with Registrar or on town and state websites for details.

For primaries, unaffiliated voters may enroll with a party by mail by the Thursday before, or in person by noon the day before. Only Party members may vote in its primary, with a 3 month wait to change from one party to another.

New Canaan's election District 1 vote at NCHS (3 Farm Road); Districts 2 & 3 vote at Saxe (468 South Ave). Polls are open, 6:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. in CT general elections. **For absentee ballot**, apply in person or mail to Town Clerk on a form provided by the Clerk, beginning 19 days before a primary or 30 days before a regular election. Return ballot to the Clerk in person or mail by 4:30 p.m. election day. *No absentee ballot can be presented in person at the polls.*

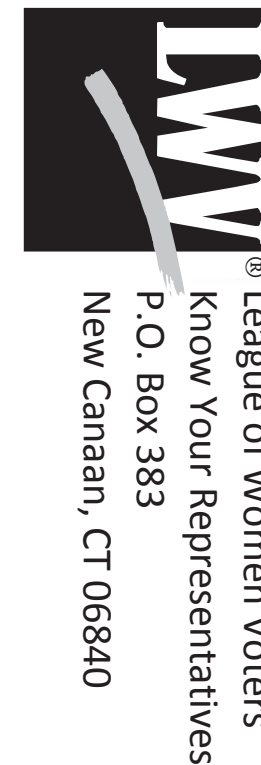
